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## CHAPTER THREE

### The shape of this world must change

The shape of this world has to change, and it will not be accomplished, by few moral standards, but by the knowledge that there is a Creator, The One and only Creator, The Lord does not judge any man, here on this earth as such, but He wants everyone to know about Him, the human race cannot afford to be divided through personal beliefs and religious superstitions.

Which causes hatred and vicious racism, after all, we all belong to the same origins and we all come from the same roots and live on the same planet. And for one to speak in another language or to have a different complex or being poor, it does not make him an alien and an outcast.

And besides, it is always the poor that are suffer, whether through natural disasters, or to make ends meet, which are classed as dirt. If it were for the Lord to judge man, He would have started from the high and mighty, the manipulators of the poor.

This is why only the scriptural knowledge shall set the human race free, by realising that at the end of the day, we came here with nothing and the same way we shall do our exit and leave here with nothing, we are only here on borrowed time. **For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and loose his own soul? Mat.16: 26.**

Which goes to prove that man cannot discern between good and evil, otherwise he would not be doing, which goes back since the beginning of time, all the wrong things, where at the end of the day shall not lead him anywhere, but to destruction.

And all those, who have taken the scriptures literally and they've predicted the coming of Christ and the end of the world, well, He is not coming in person, the coming of Jesus is spiritual and not physical, neither the end of the world is anywhere near as yet, (metaphorically speaking). Till all

the knowledge of His Word is preached, and God made known, right through our globe, 2000 years went by, where is He?

Christ said; and this was two thousand years ago that He is coming quickly, the thing is He hasn't come, is the Christ a liar then? This is the reason why we cannot take the scriptures literally, because it has driven man round in circles, confusion and in despair.

And what about the antichrist and the beast, he hasn't appeared either so, what is going on? Something is wrong somewhere, isn't it.

**The beast is none other than man himself, the man of lawlessness**

## The son of perdition - the carnal man

The beast, which everyone is made to believe that is the devil, is none other than man himself, this is why he has the number of a man, and here is the wisdom and the understanding, to work out his number, which is given. So, what is there to work out and why does one need wisdom and understanding to do it? **Revelation 13:18.**

The man of lawlessness and of iniquity is referring to the carnal minded man who is enmity against God. The seed of the serpent is within man and it is the bad seed from of the branch of the tree of knowledge.


A man becomes wise in 6 days by walking 60 stadia to receive 600 fragments of the bread, the bread of affliction and sorrow by eating from the tree of the knowledge of good and evil, The scriptures give it to us backwards, 600 and three score 60 and 6.

Twelve baskets of the bread, 12x50 fragments in each basket, which equal 600 fragments of the bread in total, referring to the spiritual knowledge of the law.

Noah lived to be 950, what if we were to divide  $900:50=18$ , which represents the 18 jars, 12 of Elijah and the six of Christ's, remembering of-course that a man has to do it three times, through the teaching of the Father, of the Son and of the Holy Spirit. (Division breaks things down).

Representing the teaching of Moses and of the Prophets and of Christ, the three measures, why do you think that Paul was by the three taverns, or Tabernacles?

Why did Simon Peter say to the Lord, "it is good for us to make three tents, (Tabernacles) one for You Lord, one for Moses and one for Elijah" The 12 jars of Elijah represent Moses and the Prophets, 6 jars each.



So we have 6 jars from the teaching of Moses, 6 jars from the Prophets and 6 jars from Christ, as we can see the three sixes. 3x6.

## The three sixes

Jesus was crucified to the world, exchanged the pleasures of this world for the richest in heaven, as an example to us, a price to pay to loose one's carnal life for the riches in Christ. The man under the law is marked, (from the beginning Cain, was marked by God and sent into the wilderness to be chastised, this is what the land of Nod 'wandering' represents) so that no one could kill his soul. (You can touch his flesh, but do not touch his soul, 'life' **Job 2:6**) Cain represents the carnal man, one side of the genealogy of Adam, from Cain to Lamech, Cain shall be avenged sevenfold (7 times) truly Lamech seventy and sevenfold (70x7) these are all keys, that no one up to now has in any way understood.

So, the three sixes represent the spiritual knowledge of the entire scriptures, which are Moses and the Prophets and Christ, this is why one needs wisdom and understanding to work them out. There is more depth obviously to the three sixes but all in good time.

And no antichrist is ever going to appear and mark any man on this planet, the confusion began many years ago by taking the scriptures literally and physically, which makes man a right idiot.

And all the battles of Armageddon are within a man and not externally and physically in the world, the flat land signifies man himself, a man being judged.

That through the teaching of Moses, which represents the water baptism in the wilderness, by receiving the laws of God through judgement, sins are being manifest.

When Moses put his hand in his bosom the first time, his hand came out with leprosy, meaning the curse of the law. And on the second time when he put his hand back into his bosom and took it out, it was restored, meaning forgiveness of sin and pointing to the Prophets. Healed through the hearing of the spirit of prophecy, the oral law, the oral Torah, because the letter kills but the spirit gives life, living in the newness of the spirit.

Curses and blessings, this is why Moses hit the rock twice for the water, referring to the law and the Prophets, because the rock that follows Moses is Christ, where only through Him sins can be forgiven.

And through the breath of Jesus, referring to the word of prophecy, 'Prophets' the testimony of Jesus, one can be saved.

**Colossians 2:11-13.**

**In whom also ye are circumcised with the circumcision made without hands, in putting off the body of the sins of the flesh by the circumcision of Christ:**

Buried with him in baptism, wherein also ye are risen with him through the faith of the operation of God, who hath raised him from the dead.

And you, being dead in your sins and the uncircumcision of your flesh, hath he quickened together with him, having forgiven you all trespasses;

Paul is talking to those in the wilderness, which are under the subjection of the law and not just anyone. Where he also testify: **Romans 1:20. For the invisible things of Him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead.**

Man up to now hasn't really understood what is sin toward God: **John 16:8-9. And when he is come, he will reprove the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgement:**

**Of sin, because they believe not on me.**

In **Luke 16:15** it is stated: **And he said unto them, Ye are they which justify yourselves before men; but God knoweth your hearts: for that which is highly esteemed among men is abomination in the sight of God.**

As we can clearly see, what man thinks is good is an abomination to God, this is why man cannot receive the knowledge of God through his own wisdom, but through the wisdom of God.

No one has realised that the cross signifies the two trees becoming one, the tree of knowledge of good and evil, when put together represents the tree of life, and not just two planks stuck together.

Meaning that one man gathering and putting all the knowledge of the entire scriptures together, by learning good and evil, which slays the fleshy carnal man, this is why the Lord begins with two trees and finishes with one tree. **Genesis 2:9 and Revelation 22:2.**

The two trees must become one, which signifies the two men, carnal man Esau, the hunter, and Jacob the spiritual man, the man of tents, 'learning' the one who bought the birthrights of his brother.

The twin brothers, where Esau was red and hairy pointing to the first Adam, because he was the firstborn, referring of-course to the carnal man. Two seeds in their mother's womb warring against each other before they were even born.

But the Lord called Jacob His 'firstborn'; I've called my firstborn Israel out of Egypt, representing the spiritual man, where Christ did fulfil that, by proving who in reality was Jacob.

What hasn't been understood is that Esau and Jacob are but the very same person, who is divided into two, but afterwards he becomes one man 'whole'. And these are the mysteries of the scriptures, the twin brothers, the two Adams, who meet after 20 years, which is but a key, where they embraced each other, meaning they became one.

$24+26=50$  referring to feast of weeks, Hebrew Shavuot,  $49+1=50$  and Pentecost the fiftieth day in the Hellenic,  $49+1+50=100$  fold. **Leviticus 23:15-1. And ye shall count unto you from the morrow after the Sabbath, from the day that ye brought the sheaf of the wave offering; seven Sabbaths shall be complete: =49 days.**

**Even unto the morrow after the seventh Sabbath shall ye number fifty days; (49+1) and ye shall offer, a new meat offering unto the LORD. (49+50=99)**

Why do you think that Abraham was 99 when he was circumcised and 100 when he had Isaac? Why did Jesus leave the 99 to find the one (1) and what do these numbers signify? The entire scriptures are written in cryptic and only the spirit can reveal them, why should the scriptures specifically give us these numbers? Everything that was written and happened was a shadow of things to come, and everything could be answered logically.

There is no way that a man of 99 and a woman of 90 could give birth, it is unnatural, and this is what the birth of Jesus signifies the spiritual man, an unnatural birth.

## Joshua and Caleb

Lets take Joshua and Caleb the only two that were left from the old generation, the only two that were allowed to lead the sons of Israel into the Promised Land. Now then, what is the significance of Joshua and Caleb, and what do they really represent?

Reading a natural story does not teach us much, just reading an historical record cannot lead anyone into the spiritual understanding and the scriptural message, unless we come to their true

significance. First of all, we have to analyse the meaning of their names, because they are given as keys.

Firstly we take Joshua or Jesus which mean 'Saviour' the son of Nun, which also mean, 'fish' and has the numerical value of '50' and also has the significance, 'gates of understanding'. Secondly, we take Caleb, which mean, 'Capable' or 'Dog' the son of Jephunneh, which also mean, 'For whom the way is prepared'. **The voice of one crying in the wilderness; prepare the way of the Lord?**

The scripture here uses two people with two names and also mentions the names of their fathers, as cryptic clues, so to lead us into greater knowledge and understanding, which proves the mysteries of the literal narrative.

Now, in this way the scriptures take us onto another level of knowledge and onto the true and correct way that they ought to be read.

## Joshua and Caleb represent but one man and used as keys

And again we have to see Joshua and Caleb as one man, one person, which are the mysteries of the scriptures that no man up to now has worked out or come anywhere close to understanding.

But firstly we have look at Israel, we read that the old generation exclusive of Joshua and Caleb, they had all died in the wilderness, the Lord told them that they shall see the land from afar, the same also applied to Aaron and Moses.

The Lord had sworn that they 'shall' not enter His rest, but only the young generation the sons, 'the seed' of Israel, the true JEW.

Moses was cut off at 120 and Aaron at 123, which are key numbers. And when Moses went to Egypt, he was 80 and Aaron 83 and when put together equals 163, a key number yet again.

## The old generation dies in the wilderness

It is very strange that all those who had suffered for forty years in the wilderness, the Lord did not allow them to enter into the Promised Land. So there must be something hidden in all these and for a good reason. Israel represents the spiritual seed and the Promised Land represents one man, one true Jew, who has to receive the spiritual seed, 'knowledge'.

## The old generation represents the old man

The old generation represents one man, the old man and the old character, the one that walks out of Egypt and into the wilderness, to receive the knowledge of God and to see the glory of the Lord.

Egypt signifies the world with its beliefs and manmade traditions and doctrines; and the reason that the scriptures use Egypt as a lesson, is because it represents a dark land. The darkness that man lives in, which in depth has nothing to do with the country of Egypt whatsoever, but an 'ever present state of mind' and used as a metaphor.

This is why the diversity of the scriptures is such that no carnal minded man could ever capture or fathom out. Because the Egyptian or Pharaoh and the Jew represent one man, who has been called and driven out by God and sent into the wilderness.

And for the fact that the Jew walked through the Sea of Reeds and as Paul adds; they've walked the Red Sea, referring to the waters of judgement and death, 'as of dry land', which was prophetic and a cryptic clue, because the Sea of reeds represents the wilderness itself. Where one man is receiving the laws of God through judgement.

Because through the knowledge of the spirit there is no difference between water and dry land, both represent the same thing, but are used as metaphors and as stages or steps or levels of understanding.

## The waters of judgement and death

God presents the Sea of Reeds, the sea of 'suf' as the journey through the wilderness, because in the scriptures there is no difference between the water and the dry land. The stones or stone must change into bread and the bread into water and the water into wine, or blood and this could only be accomplished through the spiritual knowledge of what is hidden behind the letter.

A disciple must also be able to draw blood out of the stone or stones, why do you think that the old proverb in English says. 'You cannot get blood out of a stone' the truth is with the knowledge

of the scriptures one could do that but not physically obviously, but through the spirit of the Word, the hidden meanings. (Stone – precious Jew-El)

So Joshua and Caleb used as keys, which are read like this; only **the Saviour is capable** to take and to carry the new man, 'for whom the way is prepared' into the Promised Land. The one whose eyes 'gates of understanding' are opened, by receiving the 50 tenths of the manna, 'son of Nun = fish = 50'. A fish has scales, the Lord said; make your scales just, meaning that one has to have the ability to weigh things up, after a certain time. Because in the beginning a man cannot weigh things up in his mind and understanding, there is more meaning obviously, what the fish really represents, and why Jesus fed the 5000 with 5 loaves and 2 fishes.

### The two thieves either side of the cross

This is what the two thieves on the cross signify, the carnal man, outer man and the spiritual man, inner man, where one repents the other doesn't, meaning that the carnal man goes down and the spiritual man goes up, descending into Sheol-Hades and ascending into Heaven. Jesus said to the repented one, today you are with me in paradise, meaning, by the two trees, which become one (the two seeds become one in Christ – the seed of Abraham not as of many seeds but in singular, as one seed). And referring to the forty-ninth day – Shavuot and the fiftieth day Pentecost, one man from the beginning – Berashith- head bath

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### The 49th and 50th day

The 49th day is the crucifixion day (born from water – judged by the law – **Moses the accuser John 5:45**) and the 50th day is the resurrection day (born from the spirit –through grace) on the 50th day the spirit comes. When we put together 49+50=99. Abraham was 99 when he was circumcised, while Sarah at 90 conceived the seed.

### Thirteen and one third plus six and two thirds

The seed obviously represents spiritual knowledge and not a number of people, the seed is the Word of the Lord. The 99 yet again is another key number, when we divide

90:  $-9=10$  referring to the ten laws in one way, but there is another side to this also. Because we have to take into account Ishmael, when he was circumcised also, when he was thirteen, when we divide 10:  $-3=3+1/3rd$  and when put together,  $10+3+1/3=13+1/3rd$ . Also, Abraham was 86 when he bore Ishmael, when 80:  $-6=13+1/3rd$ , why? What does the thirteen and a third signify? Also the law was given 430 years after Abraham, when we divide  $400:30=13+1/3rd$ . And as I've indicated earlier about the cryptic number 46, the number of years that it took to build the Temple for the third time, which when we divide  $40:-6=6+2/3rds+13+1/3rd=20$ , what does this number refer to, does it refer to the 6 jars containing two and three measures?

**Ezekiel 4:4-6** was told by the Lord to lie on his left side for 390 days for the sins of Israel and on his right side for 40 days, to bear the sin for the house of Judah. When put together,  $390+40=430$ , when also divided 400:  $-30=13+1/3rd$ .

Also Paul received 40 less 1 when 40:  $-3=13+1/3rd$ , bearing in mind that the Lord does things in threes, a Triadic God into one God, because God is one. I will only reveal this to people who are interested to learn. When we also go to **Daniel 8:14**. **And he said unto me, Unto two thousand and three hundred days; then shall the sanctuary be cleansed.**


So, 2000:  $-300=6+2/3rds$  the sanctuary obviously represents man, the Temple of God, which also points to the Messiah, and also, 23000 fell in one day, **1 Cor.10: 8**, wherefore also, when we divide  $20000:3000=6+2/3rds$ , what do these numbers really signify and why they've been given? Why when all these cryptic numbers when divided, lead to the same number?

Also, why did Abram take three animals three years old and divided (cut) each animal in two parts, making up six parts, three times two or two times three, which he skinned, animal skins? What was our father Abram doing? And why were the animals the heifer the she goat and the ram three years old? Which is a cryptic, for the fact that the animals were three years old, obviously! And also why was the sacrifice made when the sun went down, where the furnace, the burning torch passed through the parts? And why did a horror of great darkness and a deep sleep fell upon Abram? **Genesis 15:9-12**. And also, why did Jesus say that it shall be two against three and three against two in the same family? **Luke 12:51-52**. Remember **that the things of the spirit of God are foolishness to the carnal minded and natural man.**

What if we were to multiply the six parts,  $6x2=12$  and also,  $6x3=18$ , 12 loaves and 18 jars? And when we put 12 over  $18=2/3rds$ . Which the same works out with the six stone jars that Jesus used at the wedding at Kana of Galilee, containing 2 to 3 measures and also  $12+18=30$ , Jesus began at 30, why is this another coincidence? As I've said the entire scriptures were written in cryptic, whether one believes (accepts) it or not.

### Two thirds the harmonious ratio

Also, why is the Lord using the two thirds, which is the harmonious ratio in mathematics and also the Pythagorean theory on music? Do you think that Pythagoras invented it by his own mind? What about Einstein, where did he get his inspirations from, and all the great philosophers, inventors and scientists, the great painters and composers?

Lysias the Hellenic philosopher said, do not let your tongue run before your mind, which obviously means, think before you speak, where the scriptures say, be quick to listen and slow to speak.

### The Mathematics of the scriptures is child's play

The mathematics of the scriptures is child's play which no one up to now has taken seriously.

1 Corinthians 1:20 Where is the wise? Where is the scribe? Where is the disputer of this world? Hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world? Also, 1 Corinthians 1:27 But God hath chosen the foolish things of the world to confound the wise;

### Jacob's age

When we look at Jacob's age when he was cut off, at 147, which is 49 three times, which points to the word of the Lord, which comes twice and three times, for one to fully understand, and also signifies the three hidden days. So,  $147+3=150$  pointing to the spirit, walking in parallel with the flesh, which is 120, so  $150+120=270$ . Which points to the nine months, (270 days) for a child to be born, the son of man, born from water, a child develops in a sack of water in his mother's womb.

Which also, indicates the origins of man and from where we all came from, life began in the water, and God created life from the waters, drawn from the waters. Which is the meaning of the name

Moses, who gets cut off at 120, which is  $40 \times 3$ . Moses was 40 when he left Egypt, he was 80 when he returned, plus another 40, which he spent in the wilderness, in all 120. Quoting; that the days of all flesh shall be 120 years, which has nothing to do with a number of years physically, but key numbers referring to the laws of God, that slay the flesh.

## The flesh gets cut off at 120

The flesh gets cut off at 120, and referring to the law, (Moses) which is  $3 \times 40 = 120$ , meaning that after the judgements of the law, which kills the fleshy man, 'born from water' because the law was given in a forty-day period, which is a key. The law was given twice 'Deuteronomy' pointing to Moses and the Prophets, the first tablets that were written by the hand of the Lord, which Moses smashed into pieces 'fragments'. Representing the hidden knowledge of the law, the spirit of the Word, 'the word of prophecy', which came through the Prophets, the Prophets teaching Israel the meaning of the law, through conviction, to draw them to repentance. The law comes to manifest sin, but not just the written law, but also the oral law; this is what Paul is explaining in his epistle to the Romans in chapter 7?

Is it not very strange that Moses came down the mountain, with the stone tablets, written on them 'I shall not kill' and he orders the sons of Levi to take their swords and killed 3000 people? Why did Samson kill 3000 Philistines in the Temple and why were 3000 devout Jews saved on the day of Pentecost? Just a coincidence or cryptic clues representing spiritual knowledge? What does the number 3000 signify and represent?

The forty and fifty day ( $40+50$ ) principle of the scriptures, which is proven from both the Hebrew and the Hellenic versions of **Genesis 7:11**. Jesus remained with his disciples for forty days and on the fiftieth day the spirit came, pointing to the spiritual seed (spiritual knowledge), descending to dwell in a man.

This is why Sarah was 90 when she conceived, which points to the flesh and the spirit walking in parallel. And again if we were to multiply  $90 \times 3 = 270$ , (270 days for a child to be born, 270 days for the gestation) but also, from 90 to 100 or from 40 to 50 there is a gap of 10 days, which are hidden. (**Cast into prison by the Devil for ten days to be tried Rev.2: 10**). This is why the 49th day is the day that the flesh dies and the 50th day is the day that the spirit comes, when one has 120 in the upper room - 120 loaves - in one's head - the entire knowledge of the law, then Christ comes. (On the 50th day the law was given after Israel received the 50ths of manna, walking 50 days to reach mount Sinai -  $49+1=50$ , which 50ths represent the law).

Which refers to the 120 loaves in the Temple on the ten tables, five to the north and five to the south, which is obvious that there were 12 loaves on each table, which the scriptures do not mention. The 5 barley loaves represent the written law, the bread of affliction and

Sorrow, the poor man's bread, which are broken into 600 fragments and contained into 12 baskets and the 7 wheat loaves, the rich man's bread and representing the oral law (the revelation and true meaning of the written law), which are broken into 350 fragments and contained into 7 baskets.  $12 \times 50 = 600$  and  $7 \times 50 = 350$  and  $600 + 350 = 950$  the age of Noah.

The Temple obviously is man himself, the threshing floor, which is built in three levels of hewn stone and one of wood, referring to the three to one proportion of the Word of God. And also in three storeys, three spiritual levels, or 3 heavens or third heaven, as Paul testifies. It would be impossible for one to reach the third heaven unless he goes through the first and second heavens to get to the third.

## Joshua the sixth book and sixth step

This is why Joshua is the sixth book of the scriptures, representing the sixth step, one man becoming a living soul, on the sixth day, like Adam, Joshua is Jesus Himself, walking all the way from Adam, imparting His knowledge. And for the fact that the name of Caleb also means 'dog' the dog is the one that the shepherd uses to gather the sheep and also referring to one, who is working very hard. Jesus declares **John 5:17 But Jesus answered them, My Father worketh hitherto, and I work.**

The scriptures, only apply to him in the wilderness, to the called out = Ekklesia, singularly, he who knows the law, the true Jew of the circumcision of the heart. As Paul confirms it in **Romans 2:28+29 and Romans 7:1**, who willingly comes under the subjection and condemnation of the law. He who wants to, he who has ears, and he who overcomes, which is about a million miles from the teaching of the so-called, modern religions.

So, it is about time that the Jew came to the realisation and true understanding of the Word of God, which are Moses and the Prophets and their fulfilment. **The Jew and the Hellen**, which has

nothing to do with, people of nationality, but what they really represent as focal points and means of teaching.

n image, without any knowledge and wisdom. As you can see only the spirit of the Word can open the eyes of the blind, those living in darkness, those apart from the light of the Lord and not physical blindness obviously, but spiritual blindness.

The invitation of the Lord applies to all men from all nationalities as a whole, those who are being called out, 'ek-klesia', the true Jew. The Jew obviously plays a major role as living evidence, Israel has already been called out, all they have to do is to learn the spirit of the word, so they could learn the will of the Lord and to recognised the true Messiah.

## The two goats

Anyway to understand that the two men in all the cases of the scriptures, are but one man, one has to go to the two goats in the wilderness. Where lots were drawn, and the one that the lot fell, which was drawn for the Lord, was taken to be sacrificed and the other one was led by a man into the wilderness to 'be taught of God'. The two goats are but the same man, who comes under grace, the scapegoat is let loose, a man set free from the power of the law by the one offered as a living sacrifice, a sin offering to the Lord (The Day of Atonement)

Leviticus 16:9-10.

(Goat 'hairy = Esau' = SA'iy'r = demon -storm = the seed of the serpent, (Hebrew) Azazel = 'scapegoat').

We have to see the two as one man, and at the same time, representing the sacrifice of Jesus, as a teaching, which he fulfilled, when baptised by John, John representing Moses and the Prophets. (John was also referred to, as Elijah, because he was the prophet who demonstrated, the water and fire 'spirit' baptism)

When Jesus ascended from the waters of judgement, the river Jordan, (signifying purification and renewal of the mind – pure conscience by the grace of God) where the dove 'spirit' sat on his head. Indicating, born from water (the laws of God) and from the spirit. **This is my beloved son in whom I am pleased** (which applies to any son, Jesus being the example to all) and immediately he was led by the spirit into the wilderness for forty 40 days to be tested three times, (3x40=120 as a key). The Lord does things back to front, He takes the future to the past and the past to the future, one of Einstein's theories, if I am not mistaken and at the same time, He brings the past and the future to the present. **From him, which is, (present) and which was (past) and which is to come, (future)**, which refers to the prophetic word. **Revelation 1:4.**

So, the water baptism of Jesus in the Jordan represents the actual cross, death of the flesh by the judgements of the laws of God. One man receiving the laws of God, through chastisement and scourging and as it is described in the Hellenic, 'to be whipped and to be taught, educated', referring to the renewal of the mind, changing the 'old wineskin', for the new wine.

What we have to understand is that the water baptism has nothing to do with dipping someone in the water, 'physical ordinance' but one man, disciple receiving the laws of God. Which stone the carnal man to death, but at the same time, the very same man is under grace. (John the Baptist = baptism by the 'grace of God' one has to 'cross' the Jordan, as of dry land, signifying the wilderness, and to receive the knowledge of the cross, to learn good and evil).

The very purpose for the scapegoat, one man being set free from the bondage of the law, when he offers himself as a burnt offering, as sin offering to the Lord, in the wilderness.

So, what Jesus demonstrated by the Jordan, as a sign, was the finished thing, the fulfilment, one man being born from water and spirit. This is why the voice from above immediately said, this is my beloved son, in whom I am pleased, referring to the one who does the will of the Father, any man, any son, who does the will of the Father.

Born from the spirit, represents the actual resurrection from the dead, one man emerging from the deep (Hades-Sheol) Jesus being submerged in the Jordan and then raised up.

Putting off the body of sin, undressing the old man and putting on the new man, the one being built according, to all the instructions of Moses and the Prophets and Jesus Christ, the three measures, a stone (clay) jar full with the 3 measures.

Jesus walking (descending) all the way from the Garden of Eden, which is a heavenly place, where in actual fact the Garden in real terms, is the heavenly Tabernacle.

This is indicated, when the Lord killed the animals, to cover Adam and Eve, a reflection of the Tabernacle in the wilderness, which was covered with animal skins, which represents a man,

carried in the wilderness. From the beginning, the Lord was building the Tabernacle, this is why He said 'Let Him Be Light and He was Light.

Jesus also proves that He is the first Adam, in **Matthew 25:36**, I was naked and you clothed me, and this is to identify Himself with the first Adam, the Alpha.

Jesus was naked only thrice, first in the Garden, second when he was born and thirdly when he was put on the cross, which represents the very same thing.

And for the fact that He spoke to the ones to His right, represents the spiritual man, and the ones to His left, represents the carnal man, one man in two, where the carnal man would not and cannot yield to God. This is why he must die, through the receiving of the laws of God, by learning good and evil.

## Jesus opens the way to any man

The Israelite was to offer a lamb or a goat or an ox as a sacrifice to the Lord, where he placed his right hand on the head of the animal, meaning that the animal stood there in his place, the animals obviously represented the servant of God.

Which Jesus, the Lamb of God took over by becoming that sacrifice Himself, by opening the way to any man, to enter into the Tabernacle. And it does not mean, as today's man thinks that he has nothing to do, because Jesus did it all and ignoring the true meaning and purpose of the wilderness.

Jesus opens the way, He stands there at the altar as the living sacrifice, where a man can place his right hand on His head, standing there for ever in the place of a man (animal). The sacrificial lamb, (the Passover) the sacrifice to the Lord to open the way, a ransom paid by blood, to cover the man walking in the wilderness and not just anyone who thinks is religious. The one, which comes under the subjection and condemnation (stoning) of the law, and at the same time, under grace and truth, the one receiving grace and truth, which are made possible through Jesus, one man in two parts, outer and inner, old and new.

And not forgetting of-course that one must follow in His footsteps, by offering himself as a living sacrifice to the Lord, '**planted together in His sufferings and into His death, so that he could be planted with Him in His resurrection**', and this is what Paul is advising.

One man being baptised into His death, not by dipping him in several feet of water, or sprinkle water on one's head, a physical ritual, but a man walking in the wilderness receiving the laws, which have been completely ignored and abolished, by all.

We could dip someone in the Marianna trench, I don't think he will emerged with his mind renewed or changed in any way, a little frightened and amazed perhaps but that's about it. No one up to now has in reality understood the significance and meaning of what the water baptism or the term '**born from water**' truly signifies and represents.

The scriptures only concern the Sons of God, those under the process for the adoption, through scourging and chastisement, so that the seed of the serpent by the power of the law might be raised.

Paul as an example confirms the very thing; where he testifies, that he lived once apart from the law, but when the law came, it slew him. Paul obviously is not talking about the letter of the law only, 'written law = Moses', but the spirit of the law, 'oral law' = the Prophets', which is the spiritual revelation of the written law.

Read **Romans 7:9-25 and 8:1-9**. The point being made, when did Paul ever live apart from the law? As he testifies that he was a Jew and a Pharisee, from the tribe of Benjamin, which mean '**the son of my right hand**', who sat at the feet of Gamaliel and he was taught the law of his fathers. **Acts 22:3**.

Gamaliel, which mean '**reward of God**' the son of Pedahzur, which mean '**the rock has ransomed**' from the tribe of Manasseh. Pointing to the teaching of Christ obviously.

Where and when the spirit of the Word, referring to the oral law comes, opens one's eyes to the understanding and the purpose of the written law. And the law that comes to manifest sin is the written law and the oral law, the word of prophecy, one must receive all the precepts of the law first, the two parts of the law, the law that kills and the law that gives life.

The written law kills the flesh 'the old man' and the oral law gives life to the new man, and where sin is abundant so grace is abundant, referring and pointing to one man.

This is why, unless the serpent is raised in the wilderness by Moses, he who has to receive the circumcision of the heart, 'the son of man' the true Jew, (the inner man), could not be raised ever, referring to the teaching and power of the law.

Ignoring completely the curses 'Ebal' and asking only for the blessings 'Gerezim' referring to the circumcision of the heart. Christianity doesn't want the seven Covenants that the Lord had made right through the centuries, they only want the eighth, because without the seven the eighth is of no avail, 'invalid'. Gerezim, which mean 'cutting' and Ebal, which mean 'stone', 'cutting stone' referring to the circumcision. (But I must also add this)...

This is why Christ speaks to the seven churches, referring of-course to the seven covenants, which one man must receive, so that he could reach the eighth, because all seven make up the eighth. And Christ is not talking to seven different so-called churches, or seven different people but to one man, singularly, he who has ears and wants to listen and to the overcomer, the victor, 'Jacob' he who overcomes the Devil (evil) and the world and struggles with God to achieve it.

This is why the last two churches, the sixth one is called 'Philadelphia' a friend of his brother, 'brotherly love' 'twinning' pointing to Jesus, the firstborn, 'spiritual brother' 'image and likeness'. And the seventh, 'Laodicea' meaning the justification of the people 'rest' a man, declared righteous by God and pointing to the Sabbath, which is also the Christ.

This is why he did all his signs (and not miracles) on the day of Sabbath, because he is the Sabbath Himself, God's rest.

## Dan and Ephraim are hidden

Why do you think in Revelation 7:4-8, two tribes are omitted, which are Ephraim, which mean 'double fruitful' and also, 'Ash-heap' and Dan, which mean 'judge' referring to judgement. And two others were added, which were Levi, which mean 'attached - joined' and Joseph, which mean 'increase', increase in all the knowledge.

Read Jeremiah. 4:15. For a voice declareth from Dan, and publisheth affliction from mount Ephraim.

And Genesis 41:52. And the name of the second called he **Ephraim**: For God hath caused me to be fruitful in the land of my affliction. (Judged by the law – the suffering of the cross and pointing to Christ).

Hosea 5:11 **Ephraim** is oppressed and broken in judgment, (Ash-heap) because he willingly walked after the commandment.

Jeremiah 31:9. For I am a father to Israel, and Ephraim is my **firstborn**. (Admah –red soil – first Adam) **Jesus walking through all of them**.


And this is how we read Revelation 7:4-8, after one has been judged 'Dan' and has become the 'double ash heap' 'ruins' -death of the flesh - 'Ephraim' to him is joined 'Levi' 'added' increase 'Joseph' of the knowledge of the Lord, referring to the mind of Christ.

The twelve tribes represent the twelve loaves, where in fact they are fourteen tribes, including Levi and Joseph, referring to Urim and Thumim, light and perfection, joined through enlightenment and increase in all the knowledge of the Lord.

The inheritance of the Lord belongs to the Levi, Levitic priesthood, which changes into the order of Melchizedek.

Royal priesthood, the Priest of the Most-High God, to whom Abram gave testimony, tithes.

Shechem, which mean 'back' or 'shoulder' and located in the valley between, mount Ebal and Gerezim. Referring to curses and blessings, Shechem obviously signifies the head of a man and the two mountains represent the shoulders of the Priest, with the two onyx stones with six names on each one.



## The scripture is not a thriller book

The scripture is not a novel or a thriller, but more like a drama, a play in words, where all its characters come and go and replaced by other characters, which lead us to the same thing.

A story that took one and a half thousand years to be put together, by someone, who had arranged and synthesised systematically and methodically all the events, which appear to be natural but in depth, they are not.

Someone, who was at the very beginning of things, and also at the very end, by someone who had planted the beginning and also the end, the author Himself, which took fifty books to contain it. (The authentic number of both, the Old and the New Testaments).

Fifty portions of light one might say, representing the fifty tenths of manna, the feast of weeks, Shavuot in Hebrew and Pentecost in the Hellenic.

## The Lord is The One who does all things

But let's read **Isaiah 45:5-9**.

5. I am the LORD, and there is none else, there is no God beside me: I girded thee, though thou hast not known me.

6. That they may know from the rising of the sun, (the entrance of the Tabernacle or the Temple) and from the west, (the exit of the Tabernacle because the boards, the tread boards open up, which signifies the resurrection) that there is none beside me. I am the LORD, and there is none else. (Signifying one man walking through the Tabernacle, from east to west).

7. I form the light, and create darkness: I make peace, and create evil: I the LORD do all these things. (The Lord judging one by His laws).

8. Drop down, ye heavens, from above, and let the skies pour down righteousness: (the flood of spiritual knowledge) let the earth open, (man's mind) and let them bring forth salvation, 'the first fruits of many' and let righteousness (Christ) spring up together; I the LORD have created it.

9. Woe unto him that striveth with his Maker! (Israel- Jacob) Let the potsherd strive with the potsherds of the earth. Shall the clay (flesh) say to him that fashioneth it, What makest thou? Or thy work, He hath no hands?

Here I must close my present message, which is nothing yet, just scraping the surface, the tip of the iceberg of the scriptural knowledge that lays hidden within the framework of the narrative, the natural story.

## There is so much knowledge to be revealed that it will amaze!

Dan 2:27-28. Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The

Secret, which the king hath demanded, cannot the wise men, the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, shew unto the king; But there is a God in heaven that revealeth secrets.

The first instruction of Christ that He gives: 'Metanoete' 'repent' change your way of thinking, can you change your way of thinking, from the way that the world thinks?

The good news is for them in the wilderness, those receiving the knowledge of the spirit of the word of God, through much denial and affliction, planted together in the sufferings and death of the real Jesus. The true meaning, of the twelve loaves, five(5) barley loaves from the feeding of the 5000 and seven(7) wheat loaves from the feeding of the 4000. All twelve become one whole big loaf, the bread that is descending from heaven, to conform one into the image of the firstborn.

What's the good news for someone who has everything? Deny all and lift up your cross and follow me? These are horrific news to a man of the world. The good news of salvation is for them who are under the sentence of death, by the accusation of the law, walking in the valley of death, where they are waiting for the Christ to come and deliver them and set them free. **Because if they don't believe Moses and the Prophets, they will not believe if someone was risen from the dead.**

Because religious ignorance condemns every man, and by threatening him that he is going to Hell? They don't even know what Hell 'Hades' in the Hellenic and 'Sheol' in Hebrew mean and represent.

Don't be ignorant, because ignorance is deafness and blindness, if you want to know the truth, so it can set you free....

Jesus is standing at the sacrificial altar forever, in our place and opens the way for any man, who shall call upon His name and follow His instructions to the full.

Christ invites all to repent, 'change your way of thinking' 'metanoia' and not they, who say to me Lord, Lord, and not just the listener, but the listener and the doer, the doer of His will.

TRemembering **that the things of the Spirit of God are foolishness to the carnal and physical man.** And unless a man becomes as a child and referring to the new-born man, the male child, he cannot enter into the Kingdom of God.

- BABYLON-A man is born into confusion, till his eyes become opened.

Moses was cut off at 120 and where Moses exits Jesus comes, meaning after the teaching of Moses, Jesus comes, (Yeshua - Joshua - Jesus - Ιησους - Saviour). **If you do not believe Moses and the Prophets you will not believe one risen from the dead, and the rock that follows Moses = (drawn from water- through the laws of God) is Christ.**

Lazarus the poor man in the bosom of Abraham (seed) and the rich man, who is not named in Hades, representing one man receiving the laws of God, a man full of earthly ambitions and dreams. The rich man had five brothers, signifying the Pentateuch, the written Torah, Law, which descends a man into the belly of the earth, the carnal man descending and the spiritual man ascending, the meaning of the cross. **Wet his finger with water = the laws** written by the finger of God, the water signifying the laws of God.

The entire scriptures are written in cryptic and in an elementary numerical language.

2 Timothy 3:16-17

**All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness:**

That the man of God may be perfect throughly furnished (in the upper room) unto all good works.

Few more insights of the scriptures:

Why also, the scriptures 1/Kings 7:26 and 2/Chronicles 4:5 testify that the sea in the courtyard of the Temple, where in one book says that the sea contained 2000 baths and in the latter book says that the sea contained 3000 baths? Is this a contradiction or hidden knowledge?

Where did Cain find a wife if he was the second man after Adam to walk the planet Earth? Where did she come from and what does she represent?

Also, Genesis 5:2. Male and female created he them; and blessed them, and called their name Adam, in the day when they were created.

Well! The questions are countless, and each and everyone has a logical answer, providing that one knows the Hidden meanings of Moses and of the Prophets, and the true meaning of the twelve loaves.

Not by power nor by might but by my Spirit says the Lord...

After all the scriptures are for those, who seek the riches in Christ, to become heirs of God and co-heirs of Christ, the Messiah...

And if someone asks where would this knowledge take me? The answer would be; to Christ because one has to receive all the fragments of the heavenly bread and also, identify oneself in the scriptures, in the book of life.

God shall pass one through all the situations and circumstances, all the tribulations according to His Word for to receive the Spirit of the Word. This is what it means to be in the wilderness, offering one's self as a living sacrifice, a burnt offering to the Lord, through devotion and dedication, to find one's self depending only upon Him (Blessed is the man, who relies upon the Lord)

Man cannot go back to the past nor could he go forward to the future but the Spirit of God could, this is the teaching of Christ, He brings the past and the future to the present. The one which is, 'present' and which was, 'past' and which is to come, 'future' the Almighty...
